MEDICAL WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

- (a) Types of waste generated;
1. Sharps
 2. Blood and Blood Products
 3. Microbiology laboratory wastes
- (b) Segregation, packaging and labeling procedures for untreated medical waste for off-site transportation;
1. Medical waste placed into red plastic 32-gallon containers lined with red bag. The “Bio-hazardous Waste” symbol is printed on the front of the container.
 2. Sharps are placed in red plastic containers that are sealable and have the “Bio-hazardous Waste” symbol on the front.

Note: You may want to add location of containers, how often the containers are picked up for off-site treatment and company responsible for pick up.

- (c) Treatment method utilized on-site;
1. All waste is shipped off site.
 2. *(or method you use within your facility, e.g. autoclave, incineration, burial)*
